Correct use

Expansion module EM-BAC-MOD provides a BACnet MS/TP or Modbus RTU interface for EASYLAB base components as well as for the TROX UNIVERSAL CONTROLLER.

Use the expansion module for the following devices:

- FASYLAB controller TCU3
- EASYLAB adapter module TAM
- TROX UNIVERSAL CONTROLLER

Incorrect use

Do not use the expansion module for areas of application that are not described in this manual.

Do not use the expansion module:

- outdoors
- in wet areas
- in areas with potentially explosive atmospheres

Residual risks

Failure of the network interface does not affect the control function of the volume flow controller but does affect data exchange with the central BMS. Safety-related applications require further precautions.

Safety signs

Qualified staff

Qualification

The work described in this manual has to be carried out by individuals with the qualification, training, knowledge and experience described below:

Network administrator

Network administrators design, install, configure and maintain the IT infrastructure in companies or organisations.



Skilled qualified electrician

Skilled qualified electricians are individuals who have sufficient professional or technical training, knowledge and actual experience to enable them to work on electrical systems, understand any potential hazards related to the work under consideration, and recognise and avoid any risks involved.

3 Structure and functional description

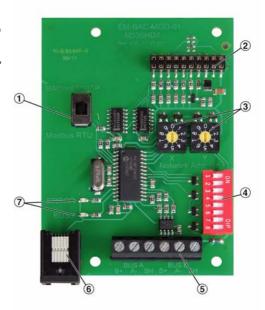


Fig. 1: EM-BAC-MOD-01

- Switch to select BACNet MS/TP or Modbus RTU protocol
- ② Plug base for connection with the EASYLAB main PCB
- 3 Switches to set the network addresses, 01-99
- 4 DIP switch to set communication parameters
- Network terminals (EIA-485) B+ signal, Asignal, SH = shield
- 6 Connection for firmware update
- Status LEDs: ERROR = communication error; BUSY = data transmission in progress

Status LEDs

There are two LEDs on the expansion module: 7

BUSY LED green

- Power supply OK

BUSY LED green, blinking

 Data transmission in progress

FRROR LFD red

- Transmission error

Structure and functional description



Functional description

Expansion module EM-BAC-MOD-01 provides the EASYLAB base components (controller TCU3 or adapter module TAM) with a BACnet MS/TP or Modbus RTU interface to link rooms or individual volume flow controllers to the central BMS.

When used on a room controller or adapter module (TAM) with active room management function (RMF), the expansion module provides an interface to access data for the entire room.

When used on a fume cupboard controller, room controller or adapter module (TAM), the expansion module provides an interface to access data for the controller.

The PCB is fitted with terminals for the EIA-485 network, configuration switches, and two LEDs that indicate the operating status. The PCB can be fitted to the TCU3 or TAM main PCB using a header. The configuration switches can be used to adapt the expansion modules to various applications and communication parameters.

5 Delivery and storage

Delivery check

Check delivered items immediately after arrival for transport damage and completeness.

Properly dispose of packaging material.

A complete shipment includes:

- EM-BAC-MOD expansion module
- Pin header
- Mounting material
 - Distance pieces (4x)
 - Fixing screws with washers (4x)
- Ground strap
- Installation manual

Carrying the expansion module

- If possible, take the module in its transport packaging up to the installation location.
- Do not remove the protective wrapping until just before installation.

Storage

If you need to store EM-BAC-MOD, make sure that the following conditions apply:

- Store in its original (antistatic) packaging.
- Do not store outdoors.
- Store in a dry and dust free place.
- Store away from direct sunlight.
- Do not expose to any aggressive media.
- Avoid any mechanical impact.
- Storage temperature: -10 °C to +70 °C.
- Relative humidity: < 90 %, no condensation.
- If a product has to be stored for more than 3 months, regularly check the general condition of all parts and of the packaging.



6 Installation

Personnel:

Skilled qualified electrician

Materials:

- EM-BAC-MOD expansion module
- Pin header
- Distance pieces (4x)
- Fixing screws with washers (4x)

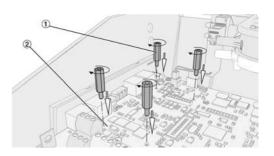

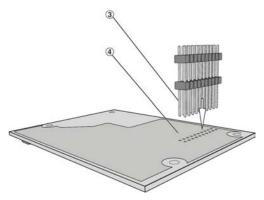
- Switch off the supply voltage and secure it against being switched on accidentally before working on any electrical equipment.
- Only skilled qualified electricians are allowed to work on live components.

Expansion module EM-BAC-MOD is to be fitted into the casing of a TCU3 controller or TAM adapter module.

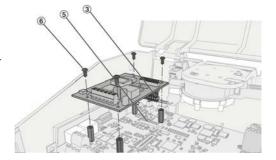
- Electrostatic charge can damage the electronics. For this reason, first touch an equipotentially bonded metal surface, e.g. a water pipe, for electrical earthing before you remove the unit from its protective wrapping. Avoid skin contact with any components or printed circuits on the expansion module or the main PCB.
- Switch off the supply voltage to the TCU3
 controller or TAM adapter module and
 secure it against being switched on accidentally. Then open the cover of the TCU3 or
 TAM casing (see instructions for the respective device).



 Screw the four distance pieces ① into the corresponding openings in the TCU3 or TAM main PCB ② and tighten them (hand-tight only).



4. Take the pin header ③ and push it with the longer ends from below through the expansion module ④; push the pin header just far enough such that the pins protrude slightly on the upper side.





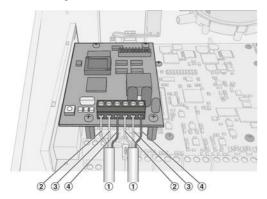
Take the expansion module PCB with the upside up and position it on the TCU3 or TAM main PCB such that the pin header ③ is exactly above the corresponding plug-in base ⑤, and the holes for the distance pieces are above the distance pieces. Then press the PCB onto the distance pieces.

In case the positions do not exactly line up, check whether the pin header is still correctly positioned. Repeat step 2.

If you have pushed the pins too far through the PCB (step 2), the electrical connection may not work properly. Repeat step 2.

Fix the PCB using the four fixing screws ⑥.
Tighten the screws only hand-tight.

Connecting data cables



- Data cable
- ② B+ (EIA-485)
- ③ A- (EIA-485)
- SH (shield)
- EM-BAC-MOD has terminals for two data cables of an EIA-485 network.

Strip the insulation from the bus cable (at least two wires), insert the bare wires into the terminals and tighten the screws by hand.

Make sure that the polarity of the conductor pairs is correct. Incorrect polarity will result in inverted data signals and hence communication errors.

Fix the data cables to the casing using the wire clamping bracket.

Connect the shield of shielded cables to the SH terminals. Within a bus segment connect the shield only at one point to the earth. Earthing the shield at every controller will lead to voltage disturbances.

A maximum of 32 units can be operated on one network segment. To avoid cable reflections, network segments must be terminated at both ends with 120Ω bus terminal resistors. PCBs of revision 2 and higher allow you to fit terminal resistors directly onto the PCB. (see page 17)

Connect the shield of shielded cables to the SH terminals. Within a chain (channel) connect the shield only at one point to the earth. Earthing the shield at every controller will lead to voltage disturbances.

Recommended data cable

Twisted pair, e.g. $JY(St)Y 2 \times 2 \times 0.8$ (use only twisted pair for B+ and A-)

 Close the cover of the TCU3 or TAM casing (see instructions for the respective device).
 Then switch on the power supply to TCU3 or TAM again.



7 Configuration

Before you use EM-BAC-MOD as a BACnet or Modbus interface module, you have to configure it to the actual application. To do so, use the switches on the interface module.

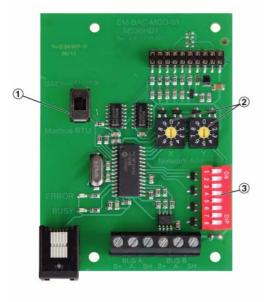


Fig. 2: EM-BAC-MOD

- Switch to select BACnet MS/TP or Modbus RTU protocol
- ② Switches to set the network addresses, 01-99
- ③ DIP switch to set communication parameters

Setting the protocol type

 Use the slide switch ① to set the BACnet MS/TP or Modbus RTU protocol.

Setting the network address

Use the two address code switches X and Y
 to set a network address (01 to 99).
 Address 00 is reserved for broadcast mode.

A maximum of 32 devices (network addresses) can be operated on one network segment. **Caution:** a different network address must be set for every device.

Setting the device family

 If the device is to be used with an EASYLAB/TROX UNIVERSAL controller or a adapter module TAM, use the DIP switch
 to set switch S1 to Off.

Communication parameters

4. Use the DIP switch ③ to set the following parameters:

S2 + S3 - Transmission speed EIA-485

S5 + S6 - Parity

S8 - Terminal resistor

Ask the responsible specialist consultant for the values to be set.

8 Commissioning

Personnel:

Network administrator

Once you have set the configuration switch to adapt EM-BAC-MOD to the network, the controller and the network can be commissioned

Commissioning a BACnet or Modbus network requires specialist knowledge as well as special network adapters and software. Only specialist personnel should do the commissioning.

Required TCU3 software version

The expansion module EM-BAC-MOD with firmware 4.1 requires the following software versions:

- EASYLAB or adapter module TAM
 - Software version 8.0 or higher
- TROX UNIVERSAL CONTROLLER
 - Software version 2.1 or higher

The software version is displayed in the EasyConnect software, 'Diagnosis', 'Basic Device' line.

A product sticker on the main PCB also carries the software version number (only for version 3 or higher).

With earlier software versions there is no data exchange between the expansion module EM-BAC-MOD and controller. This means that the network is not able to read out current values from the controller or to send any values.



You need not adapt the controller configuration with the EasyConnect configuration software for the expansion module to work.

- Only skilled qualified electricians are allowed to work on live components.
- Equipotential bonding is required.

Removal

- Make sure that the voltage supply has been interrupted.
- Unplug the network cable.
- Remove ground strap.
- Remove the expansion module.

Disposal
